We will ask you to bring a packed lunch to enjoy during a shared lunch session. During the garden visit there will be an opportunity to purchase afternoon tea in their café.

Workshop leader John Harley is a drama therapist and minister, who has led retreats for the Art and Spirituality network, and been an art teacher for twenty years. He is especially interested in harnessing art making and creative exercises to get in touch with our spiritual and intuitive selves.
